SALES TAX PROPOSITION																		
Shall the City of South Sioux City, Nebraska, continue to impose an additional sales and use tax of one-half of one percent (0.5%) (which is in addition to the 1% sales and use tax already in perpetual existence, for a total sales and use tax of 1½%), upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, for the following purposes:																		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% of such proceeds shall be used to assist in the payment of any of the City's combined utility bonds, whether outstanding or to be issued, so as to provide relief to the customers of the utility services provided by the City. • 25% of such proceeds shall be used for public safety purposes, including, but not limited to the construction of fire stations or other public safety related buildings, the acquisition of public safety vehicles and equipment, and the payment of any bonds issued for the purpose of paying the cost of the construction of any such buildings or the purchase of any such public safety vehicles or equipment. • 15% of such proceeds shall be used for street maintenance and repairs, and improvements to City parks. • 10% of such proceeds shall be used to fund the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Program currently being submitted for approval to the voters of the City; provided, that if such Economic Development Program is not approved by the voters of the City, such sales tax proceeds shall be evenly divided with ½ of the same applied towards the payment of the City's combined utility bonds and ½ applied for street maintenance and repairs, as provided in the preceding paragraphs. 																		
Such sales and use tax shall continue in perpetuity. The continuation of such sales and use tax, and the use of the proceeds of the same, shall be implemented immediately after the City has satisfied its obligations under the conditions of the additional sales and use currently in effect; to wit: the expiration of ten years from the date such tax went into effect or the collection of funds sufficient to retire the bonds issued for the construction of the Dakota County Jail/Correctional Facility, as approved by the voters of the City at the election held on August 10, 2004.																		
(If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such tax, then the governing body of the City of South Sioux City shall be empowered as provided by Section 77-27,142 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 2003, as amended, and shall forthwith proceed to impose a tax pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the governing body of the City of South Sioux City shall not impose such tax.)

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM																		
"Shall the City of South Sioux City, Nebraska establish an economic development program as described herein?"																		
a. The program will be in existence in perpetuity, unless repealed under the provisions of the Nebraska Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act.																		
b. The collection of funds, made possible through a separate ballot issue, will be from a portion of a ½ of 1% sales and use tax, to be collected pursuant to the terms of said separate ballot issue.																		
c. The amount to be collected annually for the Economic Development Program will be approximately \$85,000.00 per year, representing approximately																		
d. The City may, as and to the extent determined advisable by the Mayor and Council, issue bonds pursuant to the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act to provide funds to carry out such economic development program.																		
e. Additional funds from other non-City sources (such as federal, state and private grants) will be sought beyond those derived from local sources revenue.																		
f. The goals of the Economic Development Program are to create and retain quality jobs and generate employment opportunities within the South Sioux City area, attract new capital investments to the community, and broaden the tax base, and create economic diversification to ensure stability and vitality
